- <u>Cause:</u> CJB (Central Junction Box) will time out after 28 days to preserve battery life.
 - <u>Action</u>: To gain entry to the vehicle after this period the mechanical key will have to be used.. By opening the door (The CAN networkwakes up) thiswill re-synch the remote back to the vehicle, this is not a fault but design intent.

Issue 2: Attempting to re-program/Reenable existing Remotes

- <u>Cause</u>: Dealers are claiming Warranty for trying to re-program existing remotes
 - <u>Action:</u> Please note that the remotes are a one time program only, once they are programmed to a vehicle they cannot be re-programmed, they can only then be enabled or disabled from the vehicle using IDS, trying to re-program will have no effect, any future claims for this may be subject to debit action

Issue 3: Cautionary note when programming/adding new keys,

Content

- <u>Cause</u>: Accidentally disabling existing remotes
 - Action: When programming new /additional keys, the IDS will ask how many keys you wish to program, please enter the total amount including the originals, i.e. If two keys are currently programmed and you want to add a third then you would have to type in 3, If only 1 is selected then the previous 2 original keys will be disabled. Once a key has been programmed/enabled to a vehicle it cannot be re-used on any other vehicle.
